ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION TO DISMISS  
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT, WITH PREJUDICE

In Order No. 1765 dated September 10, 1999, the above-named Complainant was ordered to submit a proposed order in the instant case to the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board).


Thereafter, on January 21, 2000, the above-referenced parties, by and through their respective counsel, filed a Stipulation to Dismiss Prohibited Practice Complaint, with Prejudice with the Board. The parties, inter alia, agreed that the complaint was moot because the underlying case before the Board has been resolved through a private settlement agreement. The parties therefore agreed to dismiss the instant complaint, with prejudice.


Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby approves the Stipulation of the parties and dismisses the instant complaint, with prejudice.
