
ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT HONOLULU POLICE
DEPARTMENT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON RESPONDENT
HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT

On March 7, 2000, Respondent HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT, City and County of Honolulu (HPD), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to continue the hearing on its motion to dismiss complaint presently scheduled on March 21, 2000 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Respondent HPD's counsel states in an affidavit attached to the motion that she is unable to attend the hearing as scheduled and that she contacted counsel for Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO who did not object to the continuance but requested rescheduling the hearing to the first week of April 2000. Respondent HPD's counsel states that she also contacted Complainant who requested that the hearing be postponed until she undergoes a second surgical procedure in approximately three months.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the instant motion to continue the hearing date in this matter until moved on by any party. Complainant is directed to advise opposing counsel when she is prepared to proceed in this matter.
