ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On July 7, 2000, Board Member Kathleen Racuya-Markrich for purposes of case management held a telephone conference call with Respondent's counsel and Complainant to discuss Respondent's motion for continuance and Complainant's Prehearing Statement.

Based on the foregoing, the Board grants Respondent's Motion for Continuance pending receipt of the stipulation to dismiss without prejudice which the parties agreed to file on or about July 12, 2000, but no later than July 24, 2000.
