ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT


On September 6, 2000, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued Order No. 1919 directing Complainant MAURO D. EDWARDS (EDWARDS) to appear at a hearing scheduled on September 29, 2000 and show cause why this complaint should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution. The Order provided that if EDWARDS failed to appear at the scheduled hearing and establish good cause, the Board would dismiss the instant complaint.

On September 29, 2000, at the time scheduled for hearing on the Order to Show Cause, EDWARDS failed to appear before the Board.

Accordingly, the Board, on its own motion, dismissed the instant complaint for lack of prosecution.
