Based on the Hawaii Labor Relations Board's (Board) knowledge and information that an agreement has been reached between the parties which has been ratified by the membership and funded by the Legislature and that S.B. 1096, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, C.D. 1, 2001 Session Laws of Hawaii, was signed into law as Act 90 on May 3, 2001 which repeals the Board's authority to designate essential positions in the event of a public worker strike,

the Board hereby dismisses the instant petitions relating to strike for lack of jurisdiction. Accordingly, the Board hereby closes the instant investigation.
