## ORDER CLOSING INVESTIGATION

On July 3, 2001, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) notified the parties that it intended to close the investigation because Respondent had complied with Order No. 2006, dated April 18, 2001, unless it received written notification from any party to the proceeding within ten days setting forth the reasons why this matter should not be closed. Thereafter, on July 6, 2001, Complainant filed a response to the Board's notice requesting verification from Respondent's counsel that the private contract at issue in this case had been terminated and would not be renewed. On July 17, 2001, Respondent, by and through her counsel, filed a statement with the Board confirming that the Interim Agreement, dated April 14, 1999 between the State of Hawaii and *epixtech, inc.*, ended on June 30, 2001. Accordingly, Respondent concurred with the Board's intent to close the instant investigation.

As Respondent has confirmed compliance with Order No. 2006, the Board hereby closes the instant investigation.
