On August 31, 2001, Complainant, by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's counsel states in an affidavit supporting the motion that his client would likely reassign the case to outside legal counsel and believed that it would preferable to withdraw the instant complaint and concentrate on the pending arbitration of the underlying grievance. Accordingly, Complainant requests that the complaint be withdrawn.

Based on the foregoing, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint.


