On September 20, 2001, Complainant, by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw its prohibited practice complaint filed on September 14, 1999 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's counsel states in a declaration supporting the motion that Complainant seeks to withdraw the instant complaint based on Respondents' representation, by letter dated September 10, 2001, that the Respondents will apply the relevant findings and conclusions of Decision No. 416A and will not be relitigating the issue of retroactive reduction of shortage differentials for Units 03, 04, and 13.

Based on the foregoing, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint.


