ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO MEDIATION
PENDING HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINTS

On September 21, 2001, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) conducted a conference in this matter. The parties were represented by their respective counsel who submitted a written stipulation that the oral agreement reached between the parties during the negotiating session on April 23, 2001, and subsequent amendment, would be implemented, with the exception of any provision concerning a differential/bonus for teachers with advanced degrees.

Thereupon, the Board ordered the parties to mediate the instant dispute pending the hearing on these complaints presently scheduled to commence on October 22, 2001 at 9:30 a.m. in the Board's hearing room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii.

The parties are directed to meet to select a mediator and report to the Board by September 28, 2001. Thereafter, if the parties are unable to select a mediator, the Board will identify five potential mediators, one of whom will be selected by the parties pursuant to the procedures set forth in Article V(E)(2)(a) of the Unit 05 collective bargaining agreement.
