ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF COMPLAINT

On February 28, 2002, Respondents, by and through their counsel, filed a Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative for the Grant of Summary Judgment with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). At the prehearing conference held in this matter on March 6, 2002, the Board scheduled a hearing on Respondents' motion on March 11, 2002 at 10:30 a.m. The Board also set March 8, 2002 as the deadline for Complainant to file a written response to Respondents' motion.

On March 8, 2002, Complainant RICHARD KEALOHA CONDON (CONDON) filed a response to Respondents' motion stating that although he contended that the Respondents violated Articles 11 and 16 of the collective bargaining agreement, he essentially agreed with Respondents' arguments to dismiss his complaint.

Thereafter, at the hearing on Respondents' motion held on March 11, 2002, CONDON withdrew his complaint.

Accordingly, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants the withdrawal of the instant complaint.
