## ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE; NOTICE OF HEARING

On April 23, 2002, SUSAN SUGARMAN FREE (FREE), proceeding <u>prose</u>, filed a prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) contending that Respondents KEVIN MULLIGAN (MULLIGAN), Union Agent, and the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, (HGEA) allegedly have engaged or are engaging in prohibited practices in violation of Hawaii Revised Statutes § 89-13.

On May 2, 2002, Respondents MULLIGAN and HGEA answered the prohibited practice complaint and filed Respondents' Motion to Dismiss and/or for Summary Judgment.

On May 7, 2002, the Board issued a notice of prehearing conference and hearing in this matter scheduling the prehearing conference on May 20, 2002 at 9:30 a.m. and the hearing on June 3, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. The notice provided that a prehearing statement should be filed with the Board two days prior to the date of the prehearing conference.

On May 15, 2002, Respondents filed its prehearing statement with the Board.

On May 16, 2002, FREE filed A Motion to Respond to Answer of Complaint Filed May 2, 2002.

On May 20, 2002, Respondents' counsel appeared for the prehearing conference and FREE failed to appear. In addition, FREE failed to file a prehearing statement and has not filed a response to Respondents MULLIGAN and HGEA's Motion to Dismiss and/or for Summary Judgment.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues this Order to Show Cause to FREE to appear at a hearing scheduled on May 29, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board's hearing room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii, to explain why this complaint should not be dismissed. If FREE fails to appear at the scheduled hearing and establish good cause, the Board will dismiss the instant complaint for lack of prosecution.

If FREE appears and establishes good cause, the Board will proceed to hear Respondents MULLIGAN and HGEA's Motion to Dismiss and/or for Summary on May 29, 2002 in the Board's hearing room and following the Order to Show Cause Hearing.
