ORDER DISMISSING PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT, WITH PREJUDICE

On May 20, 2002, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued Order No. 2087, Order to Show Cause Why Complaint Should Not Be Dismissed; Notice of Hearing, because Complainant failed to appear on that day for the prehearing conference scheduled in this matter. The Board ordered Complainant to appear on May 29, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. to explain why the complaint should not be dismissed. The Board indicated in its order that if Complainant shows good cause for failing to appear at the previously scheduled prehearing conference, the Board would proceed to hear arguments on any dispositive motion filed by Respondents.

Thereafter, on May 20, 2002, Respondents filed a motion to dismiss the prohibited practice complaint. Complainant did not respond to Respondents' motion to dismiss.

On May 29, 2002 at 10:10 a.m., the Board convened the hearing on the Order to Show Cause and noted that Complainant failed to appear.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby dismisses the instant complaint with prejudice for lack of prosecution.
