STIPULATION & ORDER REGARDING ATTORNEY'S FEES

COME NOW the United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), Cheryl Okuma-Sepe, and Jeremy Harris (Respondents) by and through their undersigned counsel and hereby stipulate and agree to resolve all remaining issues in the above entitled matter following the issuance of Order No. 2115 by the Hawaii Labor Relations Board as follows:

- 1. Respondents Okuma-Sepe and Harris shall cease and desist from refusing to select an arbitrator in a timely manner under Section 15 of the applicable collective bargaining agreement with UPW because respondents dispute the arbitrability of the grievance for procedural or substantive reasons.
- 2. Respondents shall reimburse UPW \$1,000 in attorney's fees and costs rendered in the prosecution of the prohibited practice complaint. Payment shall be made forthwith

by the City and County of Honolulu to UPW through undersigned counsel.
