ORDER DECLARING IMPASSE

As no party has given written notice of an impasse and there are unresolved issues in the negotiations over a renewed agreement for Unit 06, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) § 89-11(c)(2), the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) hereby declares that an impasse exists in negotiations. In accordance with the foregoing statute, February 1, 2003 is the date of impasse.

During the first 20 days of the impasse, either party may request the Board to appoint a mediator, pursuant to HRS § 89-11(d)(1). If the impasse continues past February 21, 2003 and no mediator has been appointed, then the Board shall appoint a mediator, pursuant to HRS § 89-11(d)(2).
