ORDER RESCINDING NOTICE OF INTENT TO DISMISS IMPASSE CASE BECAUSE OF MOOTNESS

On May 5, 2003, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Impasse Case Because of Mootness (Notice) based on information that a settlement had been reached in the instant impasse. In reviewing the Memorandum of Agreement entered into between the parties, dated April 23, 2003, which provides that the parties will continue to meet from time to time and bargain on wages and if the matter of wages remains at impasse after January 2, 2004, then either party may engage in a strike or lockout to resolve the impasse, it appears that parties acknowledge that certain issues remain at impasse and a settlement on a successor agreement has not yet been reached.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby rescinds its Notice, dated May 5, 2003 for good cause.


