ORDER RESCINDING NOTICE OF INTENT TO
DISMISS IMPASSE CASE BECAUSE OF MOOTNESS

On May 5, 2003, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Impasse Case Because of Mootness (Notice) based on information that a settlement had been reached in the instant impasse. In reviewing the Memorandum of Agreement entered into between the parties, dated April 25, 2003, the parties agreed, inter alia, to extend the 1999-2003 collective bargaining agreement from July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2005. The parties also agreed to negotiate wages and other cost items in the event increases were obtained by Units 02, 03, 04 or 13 during the duration of the agreement.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby rescinds its Notice, dated May 5, 2003 for good cause.
