ORDER RESCINDING NOTICE OF INTENT TO
DISMISS IMPASSE CASE BECAUSE OF MOOTNESS

On May 5, 2003, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Impasse Case Because of Mootness (Notice) based on information that a settlement had been reached. By letter dated May 12, 2003, Randy Perreira, Exclusive Representative HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO's (HGEA) Deputy Executive Director, informed the Board that the parties have agreed to extend the current agreement until June 30, 2004 provided that either party may terminate the extension upon 30 days notice anytime after January 1, 2004. Thus, the HGEA has not reached settlement on a successor agreement with the Employers and requests that this case remain open until a successor agreement is effectuated for the bargaining unit.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby rescinds its Notice, dated May 5, 2003 for good cause shown.
