ORDER DENYING PETITIONS TO INTERVENE

On November 20, 1978, a petition to intervene was filed in the above-referenced case by Valerie M. Godley and Theodore B. Jordan, on behalf of themselves and all others similarly situated.

Both Mr. Jordan and Ms. Godley did not appear at either the prehearing or the hearing, although adequate notice of both the prehearing and the hearing was published in the Honolulu Advertiser and Honolulu Star Bulletin on October 26 and November 2, 1978, prior to the filing of their petition.

During the hearing herein on November 27, 1978, the Board was informed that Mr. Jordan was no longer an employee of the University of Hawaii. In view of this fact, he had no statutory or other right to participate in this proceeding.

Ms. Godley's right to intervene in the above-referred to case is also in doubt, but could have been resolved had she appeared at the hearing herein.


