ORDER DISMISSING IMPASSE CASE

The Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Impasse Case Because of Mootness on January 23, 2004. On February 3, 2004, Exclusive Representative STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS (SHOPO), by and through its counsel, filed a response to the notice indicating that there is a final and binding arbitration award for the collective bargaining agreement covering July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2007. However, counsel stated that funding for the first year by the City and County of Honolulu was not complete and that the City Council intended to act upon a supplementary budget request in March 2004 to address retroactive pay payable in May or June 2004. SHOPO therefore requested that the Board refrain from issuing a dismissal until the contract was funded or alternatively, that the dismissal be without prejudice.

As the relevant time periods referenced by SHOPO's counsel have passed, the Board finds that the parties are no longer at impasse and hereby dismisses this case.
