ORDER APPOINTING A MEDIATOR

On September 13, 2004, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its representative, filed a written notification to the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) that it initiated negotiations over a collective bargaining agreement for employees in bargaining unit 09 (Registered professional nurses) on December 15, 2003 and an impasse has been reached in contract negotiations. Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes § 89-11(c), September 13, 2004 is the date of impasse.

To assist the parties, the Board has asked the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service to provide a mediator to assist the parties in the voluntary resolution of their dispute. Federal Mediator Ken Kawamoto has agreed to serve and is hereby appointed as mediator in the instant impasse.
