WITHDRAWAL OF PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT


On November 1, 2004, Complainant's counsel filed a letter with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) requesting the withdrawal of the instant prohibited practice complaint filed on April 19, 2004, based on the fact that the police officer involved in the case has voluntarily resigned from the Honolulu Police Department. Previously, by Order No. 2270, the Board continued the evidentiary hearing scheduled on August 5, 2004 to November 9, 2004, to afford the parties an opportunity to amicably resolve this matter.

Based on the foregoing and for good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's request to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes § 12-42-44.
