OF PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT, WITHOUT PREJUDICE


On November 10, 2004, Complainant, by and through its counsel, filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Complaint Without Prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant requested the withdrawal of the instant prohibited practice complaint filed on October 14, 2004, without prejudice, because of subsequent developments after the filing of the complaint and the decision of the union to proceed through the grievance-arbitration process.

Respondents do not object to the withdrawal of the instant complaint.

Based on the foregoing and for good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's request to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint, without prejudice, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes § 12-42-44.


