## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND MAKING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION PART OF CASE

On February 27, 1979, the Hawaii Government Employees' Association (hereafter HGEA) petitioned to intervene in the above-referenced case.

The petition is granted.

Simultaneously with its filing of said petition, the HGEA filed a Motion to Reconsider a paragraph in Decision 95 of this Board which states:

> The August 28, 1973 letter is hereby rescinded in its entirety. Henceforth, all changes in unit composition must be brought to the attention and receive the approval of this Board before they may become effective. While stipulations may be used, in appropriate cases, they will be rejected unless accompanied by sworn affidavits setting forth sufficient facts as to the work performed by the occupants of the positions involved to enable the Board to rule on the desired unit changes. Because the HGEA's motion raises issues substantially similar to the petitioner's request for a declaratory ruling herein, the HGEA's motion will be treated as having been made as part of Case Nos. DR-03-34, DR-04-34, and DR-13-34 and will be considered during the proceedings in said cases.
