On February 9, 2005, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) filed a Motion to Withdraw Complaint Based on February 3, 2005 Memorandum with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant submitted Department of Public Safety Interim Director Richard T. Bissen's (Bissen) February 3, 2005 memorandum rescinding former Director JOHN F. PEYTON's November 8, 2004 memorandum regarding the Corrections Peace Officers Foundation which was the gravamen of this complaint in support of the motion. Thus, Complainant seeks a withdrawal of the instant complaint in reliance on Bissen's remedial actions.

Based on the foregoing, pursuant to the Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants the Complainant's motion to withdraw the instant complaint.


