RE: BARGAINING UNIT INCLUSIONS AND EXCLUSIONS



¹The Board of Regents previously submitted its Stipulations with the Hawaii Government Employees Association and the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly to the Board in 2002.


Stipulations to its final order closing the investigation. For uniformity, the lists of positions should include the Job Title, Position No., Incumbent, and the Effective Date.
