ORDER GRANTING HGEA/AFSCME'S MOTION
FOR LEAVE TO FILE AMENDED PROHIBITED
PRACTICE COMPLAINT, FILED ON NOVEMBER 10, 2005

On November 10, 2005, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) filed a Motion for Leave to File Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant requests that leave be granted to file an Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint pursuant to the Board's rules.

Having heard no objection from Respondents, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to amend its Complaint pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-43.
