ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE; AND NOTICE OF HEARING

On January 3, 2006 at 10:58 a.m. the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) convened the hearing scheduled on Respondent DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, State of Hawaii's(DOE) Motion to Dismiss filed on November 28, 2006. Respective Counsel for Respondents HAWAII STATE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION and the DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION were present and Complainant failed to appear at the scheduled hearing.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues this ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE to ADELAIDE NAKAMURA to appear at a hearing scheduled on January 9, 2006 at 1:00 p.m. in the Board's hearing room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii, to show cause and explain why this case should not be dismissed, with prejudice, for lack of prosecution. If Complainant fails to appear at the scheduled hearing and establish good cause, the Board will dismiss the case for lack of prosecution. In the event Complainant establishes sufficient cause not to dismiss the complaint for lack of prosecution,


the Board will proceed to hear arguments on the Respondent DOE's motion to dismiss the complaint.
