
ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL

On January 30, 2006, Petitioner, by and through its counsel, filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Petition for Declaratory Ruling with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Petitioner submitted the withdrawal pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-24 and referred to a letter dated January 27, 2006 from Walter Harrington, Assistant DPO, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY (Harrington), to Dayton M.
