ORDER CLARIFYING DECISIONS 94 and 101

On March 8, 1979, the Petitioner Hawaii State

Teachers Association (hereafter HSTA) moved this Board for
a clarification of a portion of Decision 94.

The language in question states:

"The HSTA is directed to petition for a service fee review no later than June 30, 1979."

The HSTA has asked in its Motion for Clarification that this Board indicate whether all deductions by the employer are to cease after June 30, 1979.

The Decision is silent on that matter. All deductions were not intended to cease after June 30, 1979, but may and should be continued pending the review of the HSTA service fee.

The Board used almost identical language in Decision 101 and, on its own motion, hereby similarly clarifies

said Decision. The deductions made under Decision 101 are to continue pending the Board review of the HGEA service fee.
