ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST
TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT, WITHOUT PREJUDICE

By letter dated March 10, 2006, Complainant requested the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) to grant a two-month continuance of the case to obtain legal representation. Thereafter, on March 20, 2006, the Board issued Order No. 2368, granting Complainant's request for continuance and rescheduling the UPW's Motion to Dismiss and/or for Summary Judgment, filed on February 23, 2006 for hearing on May 24, 2006.

On May 16, 2006, Complainant filed a letter with the Board informing that despite his efforts to seek legal representation, he has not been able to retain counsel. He therefore requested that the case be "dropped against the U.P.W." without prejudice.

Pursuant to Complainant's request, the Board hereby grants Complainant's request to withdraw his complaint, without prejudice.
