On July 27, 2006, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw the instant complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) §12-42-44, because the parties have resolved the underlying dispute. The UPW attached a copy of the Settlement Agreement, dated July 18, 2006 in support of its motion. Thereafter, on July 31, 2006, Respondents, by and through their counsel, filed a Statement of No Objection to Motion to Withdraw Complaint with the Board, confirming the resolution of the dispute and requesting that the case be closed upon the Board's approval of the withdrawal of the complaint.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants the UPW's motion to withdraw its complaint pursuant to HAR § 12-42-44. This case is closed.
