On September 25, 2006, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board ("Board") conducted a hearing on HGEA/AFSCME'S Motion to Dismiss Complaint Filed on July 26, 2006, and Statement of Particularization Filed on August 10, 2006. Respondents' counsel appeared at the hearing and Complainant, pro se, did not appear. After hearing argument on the motion, the Board indicated that it was inclined to grant Respondents' motion to dismiss the complaint. Thereafter, on September 26, 2006, Complainant filed a Motion to Dismiss Complaint with the Board requesting that the Board dismiss the complaint and acknowledging citation to the "wrong HRS."

Viewing Complainant's motion as a motion to withdraw his complaint pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") § 12-42-44 and good cause appearing therefore, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion. This case is closed.


