ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO AMEND

On December 5, 2006, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO ("UPW") filed a Motion to Amend Prohibited Practice Complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board ("Board"). Complainant requests that leave be granted to file a First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint to clarify that Complainant is alleging that Respondent retaliated against UPW Shop Stewards Howard Kahue and Donald Lum for their activities which are protected by Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") by issuing written reprimands to them.

Having heard no objection from Respondent, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to amend its Complaint pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-43. Complainant shall forthwith file its First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint with the Board. The Board will thereupon issue a Notice to Respondents of the First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint and Respondent shall file a written answer to the amended complaint within ten days after service of the First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint.
