ORDER GRANTING LESLIE'S PETITION FOR  
INTERVENTION; AND NOTICE OF BRIEFING SCHEDULE

On October 10, 2007, GORDON LESLIE (LESLIE), pro se, filed a petition for intervention with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) in this matter. LESLIE alleges that his rights were violated by the Department of Public Safety (PSD) when he was suspended according to PSD's internal management rule of the "Standards of Conduct." LESLIE therefore supports the instant petition which seeks to nullify disciplinary actions when applicable statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations, orders and policies have not been filed with the Board.

The Board conducted a conference on October 11, 2007 attended by Herbert R. Takahashi, Esq., appearing for Petitioner UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), Peter Liholiho Trask, Esq., appearing for the Intervenor HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), Deputy Attorney General Julian T. White, appearing for Intervenor CLAYTON A. FRANK (FRANK), Director, PSD, State of Hawaii, Deputy Corporation Counsel Diane A. Noda appearing for Intervenor HARRY KIM (KIM), Mayor, County of Hawaii, via telephone, and LESLIE, pro se. Although LESLIE's petition for intervention was filed with the Board after the deadline set for the filing of petitions for intervention, counsel for the respective parties had no objection to his intervention in these proceedings.

Based on the foregoing and in the absence of objection, the Board finds that LESLIE has alleged a sufficient interest to intervene in this case and accordingly, grants his petition for intervention pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) §§ 12-42-8(g)(14) and 12-42-9(e).
