At the prehearing/settlement conference held in this matter on December 20, 2007, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) orally moved to amend its complaint. The Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) permitted Respondents to file a response to Complainant's oral motion to amend its complaint by September 27, 2007 and scheduled a hearing on Complainant's motion to amend the complaint on December 28, 2007 at 9:00 a.m., if necessary.

On September 27, 2007, Respondents' counsel Gregory M. Sato, Esq., notified the Board that Respondents stipulated to the amendment of the complaint. Further, Respondents incorporated its prior answer by reference and denied the amended allegation. In view of their representations, Respondents requested that the hearing on Complainant's motion to amend its complaint be cancelled.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the Complainant's motion to amend its complaint pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-43. Complainant shall forthwith file its First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint with the Board. The Board will thereupon issue a Notice to Respondents of the First Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint.
