ORDER CLARIFYING DECISION 96

On November 27, 1978, this Board issued Decision 96 certifying, as reasonable, a monthly service fee for employees in Units 1 and 10 for the period from July 1, 1978 through June 30, 1979.

Decision 96 contained the following language: "The UPW is directed to petition this Board for a service fee reveiw [sic] no later than June 30, 1979." Question has been raised as to whether this means that all deductions by the employer are to cease after June 30, 1979. The Decision is silent on this matter.

On its own motion, this Board hereby clarifies Decision 96. All deductions were not intended to cease after June 30, 1979, but may and should be continued pending the next review of the UPW service fee.
