
ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO  
WITHDRAW COMPLAINT, FILED ON OCTOBER 2, 2008

On October 2, 2008, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA or Union), by and through its counsel, filed a Motion to Withdraw Complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant alleges that the parties have selected an arbitrator to hear the subject grievance; that all matters raised by the prohibited practice have been resolved, and each party will bear its own fees and costs.

Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw the instant complaint.
