In accordance with the foregoing statute, February 1, 2009 is the date of impasse.

To assist the parties, the Board has asked the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service to provide a mediator to assist the parties in the voluntary resolution of their dispute. Federal Mediator Ken Kawamoto has agreed to serve and is hereby appointed as mediator in the instant impasse.
