ORDER DECLARING AN IMPASSE AND APPOINTING A MEDIATOR


As no party has given written notice of an impasse and there are unresolved issues in the negotiations over a renewed agreement for Unit 04, pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) § 89-11(c)(2), the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) hereby declares that an impasse exists in negotiations. In accordance with the foregoing statute, February 1, 2009 is the date of impasse.

To assist the parties, the Board has asked the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service to provide a mediator to assist the parties in the voluntary resolution of their dispute. Federal Mediator Ken Kawamoto has agreed to serve and is hereby appointed as mediator in the instant impasse.


