## ORDER GRANTING HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW SECOND AMENDED PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED APRIL 1, 2004, AS TO CLAIMS MADE BY HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO, FILED ON MARCH 9, 2009

On March 9, 2009, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its counsel, filed a Motion to Withdraw Second Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint Filed April 1, 2004 (Second Amended Complaint), as to Claims Made by Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME, Local 152, AFL-CIO with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant HGEA's counsel states in a declaration attached to the motion that the HGEA seeks to withdraw the Second Amended Complaint only as to claims made by the HGEA and be dismissed from the case because the HGEA no longer wished to pursue these claims. Complainant HGEA's counsel also states that the withdrawal of HGEA's claims will not prejudice any party remaining in this case.

Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and

with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw the Second Amended Complaint as to its claims.
