On August 7, 2009, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA), by and through its counsel, filed a Motion to Withdraw Complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules §§ 12-42-8 and 12-42-44. Complainant's counsel does not state a reason for the withdrawal or opposing counsel's position on the motion. On August 10, 2009, Respondent's counsel notified the Board that Respondent does not object to the withdrawal of the instant Prohibited Practice Complaint (Complaint).

Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw its Complaint in this matter.
