EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PARTICULARIZATION OF COMPLAINT

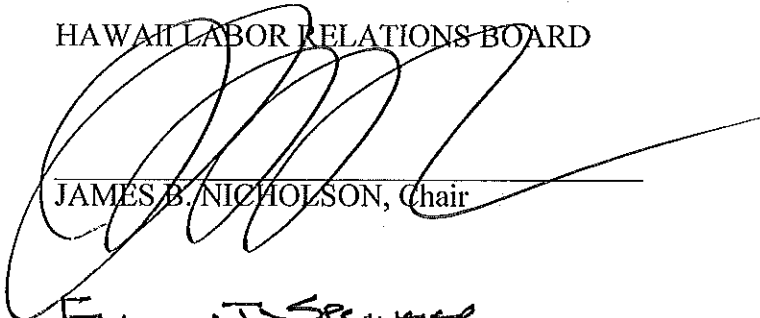
On October 27, 2009, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued Order No. 2657, Order Approving Complainant's Request for an Extension of Time to File Particularization of Complaint, extending the due date for the filing of Complainant ERIK D. BARNES' (Barnes) Particularization of the complaint to November 3, 2009.

On October 29, 2009, Barnes filed a second request to extend the due date for the Particularization to November 11, 2009 due to "personal complications" and indicating that opposing counsel agreed to the extension.
