
ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF COMPLAINT, WITH PREJUDICE


On January 19, 2010, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) conducted a hearing by conference call on Respondent's Motion to Dismiss Complaint and/or for Summary Judgment filed on December 21, 2009. Following the arguments of Respondents' counsel, Complainant TERESA YUMI RADTKE (Radtke), pro se, appearing by telephone, indicated that her concerns underlying the instant prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) had been resolved and she requested withdrawal of the Complaint. Respondents' counsel had no objections to the withdrawal of the Complaint, with prejudice.

Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants withdrawal of the instant Complaint, with prejudice.
