On February 1, 2010, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) filed a Motion to Withdraw Prohibited Practice Complaint (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). HGEA's counsel stated in a declaration filed in support of the Motion that she spoke with opposing counsel who did not object to Complainant's request to withdraw the Complaint.

Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants HGEA's Motion.
