On February 3, 2010, the above parties filed a Stipulated Withdrawal of Prohibited Practice Complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The parties represented that Bargaining Unit 07 has ratified a new collective bargaining agreement retroactive to July 1, 2009 and the new agreement replaces the language upon which the complaint was based.

Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the withdrawal of the instant Complaint.
