On March 8, 2010, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (Complainant or UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a motion for withdrawal of its prohibited practice complaint filed February 12, 2009 based upon an agreement between the parties to resolve the matters underlying this complaint by the issuance of an amended Step 2 decision, dated February 23, 2010.
