
ORDER GRANTING HGEA/AFSCME'S MOTION TO
WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED ON APRIL 7, 2010

On June 22, 2010, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA/AFSCME) filed a Motion to Withdraw Prohibited Practice Complaint (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). HGEA/AFSCME's counsel stated in a declaration, dated June 22, 2010, that the parties have successfully resolved the dispute in this case with the agreement that HGEA/AFSCME would withdraw its complaint and opposing counsel had no objection to the withdrawal of the complaint.

Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants HGEA/AFSCME's Motion.
