
ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO  
WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT, FILED ON JUNE 29, 2010

On June 29, 2010, Complainant BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii (BOR) filed a Motion to Withdraw Prohibited Practice Complaint (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) because the parties have executed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) addressing the matters alleged in the Prohibited Practice Complaint and there are no remaining claims to be resolved. BOR's counsel stated in a declaration, dated June 29, 2010, that the withdrawal is pursuant to the terms of the MOU.

Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the BOR's Motion.
