
ORDER DISMISSING CASE


On February 29, 1979, the Hawaii Nurses Association (hereafter HNA) petitioned this Board in the above-entitled case for certification of a reasonable service fee for all employees in Unit 9, registered professional nurses.


On July 10, 1979, while the above-entitled service fee case was still pending before the Board, the HNA lost its status as the exclusive representative of Unit 9. 89-4(a), HRS, states "If an employee organization is no longer the exclusive representative of the appropriate bargaining unit, the [service fee] deduction shall terminate."

Based upon the foregoing subsection, due to the loss of its status as exclusive representative of Unit 9, the HNA is no longer entitled to service fee deductions. Accordingly, on its own motion, the Board hereby dismisses the petition for certification of the reasonableness of the service fee.
