

ORDER GRANTING HSTA'S MOTION TO

On August 3, 2010, Petitioner HAWAII STATE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (HSTA) filed a motion to amend its Petition for Clarification or Amendment of Appropriate Bargaining Unit (Petition) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) to remove the E-school issue which will be raised in a separate unit clarification petition. Petitioner states that the Intervenors have no objections to the amended petition.
